In August 2016, Alumna Jean Cutrone Williams '02 gave birth to a baby boy - Ryan - who was born with a Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia, a condition where the diaphragm does not fully form, allowing the abdominal organs to enter the chest cavity and prevent lung growth. CDH has a 50% survival rate so little Ryan is a miracle!
