Dear Parents/Guardians,

Students of St. Saviour High School who are in need of receiving the sacrament of Confirmation will have the opportunity to take part in a program of preparation here at St. Saviour next year. The diocese recommends a program at their own high school so that students can journey in their faith together and receive support from the school community. Interested students will meet here at St. Saviour approximately once a week from the end of September until mid-April. Students who full-fill the requirements should be able to receive the sacrament of Confirmation here at St. Saviour Church at the Easter vigil.

Confirmation is the last of the three Sacraments of Initiation in the Catholic Church sealing you with the gifts of the Holy Spirit that you received at Baptism. It is a time of decision to take ownership of your faith and become strengthened to live it out in the world.

There is no cost to this program, other than a possible book and the attendance at a Catholic youth event to full-fill the retreat requirement. Service hours are also required.

Unfortunately, this program is only for baptized Catholics who have already received the sacrament of first Holy Communion. If you are interested in becoming Catholic or receiving the other sacraments, please inquire at your local parish or let us know and we can try to help you find the program you need.
