

Dear Class of 2019 and Parents,

On **Wednesday, September 20, 2017**, a representative from ACHIEVA Ring Company will be at St. Saviour High School to measure the juniors for their high school rings.

St. Saviour's Ring Night ceremony is a lovely tradition which will take place on **December 15, 2017** in St. Saviour Church. On this evening, our juniors receive their rings.

Purchase of a school ring is optional, but no other ring bearing the St. Saviour High School name or emblem is permitted. The school makes no profit from the sale of these rings in an attempt to keep the cost down.

Our school ring is of a traditional design with a sardonyx stone bearing the school crest in gold, as well as the year of graduation. This year there will be *two options* for you to choose from:

- **10K Gold ring – price is \$506.27**
- **Yellow Aztec ring (equivalent of 6K gold) – price is \$397.39**

If you wish to order a ring, you must bring in a \$200.00 deposit to school measurement day, **9/20/17**. Checks and money order should be made out to **ACHIEVA** (please do not make them out to St. Saviour H.S.!). Credit card payments are also acceptable. No orders will be taken without a deposit. The **balance** of the payment will be due on **Thursday, November 16, 2017**. All rings must be paid in full at this time in order to receive them at Ring Night.

We welcome every member of the class of 2019 to be a part of this special ceremony. If you are unable to purchase a ring, used rings have been generously donated back to our school by past graduates. Please let Ms. Cush know if you are interested in acquiring one of these free donated rings.

*Students who have family members who are graduates of St. Saviour High School also have the option of using that family member's ring. Alumni family members of the student may present the student with her St. Saviour ring as part of the ceremony.* If you plan on using someone else's ring for the ceremony, and/or would like an alumni family member to present you with your ring, you must give all that information to Ms. Cush as soon as possible, including the alumna's full name (including maiden name) and year of graduation.

We congratulate each junior on reaching this monumental point in her high school career, and look forward to a beautiful Ring Night ceremony. Please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.
