From the Guidance Office: NY Exploring Partnership

The Guidance Department has begun a partnership with [NY Exploring](#), an organization affiliated with the Boy Scouts of America, that offers high school students opportunities to participate in short term internships with local agencies, businesses, and institutions, as a way of exploring a wide range of career paths.

Many students have already registered to participate in a program at Methodist Hospital that will run for four consecutive Wednesdays from 4:30 PM to 6:00 PM, beginning on May 24. They will be introduced to all departments within the hospital so that they can understand the complexity and range of career opportunities in the medical field.

Other programs on offer this month – with similar time commitments – will run at the Port Authority, in the World Trade Center (Engineering and Construction), and at Sterling Bank, Herald Square (Banking). Some of our students have already expressed an interest in participating.

This program will continue into the 2017-18 school year and will include opportunities to intern at the Brooklyn D.A.'s office, as well as other organizations. NY Exploring also offers a Mock Trial Program that runs during the school year and is open to any St. Saviour student that wishes to participate.

Toparents of graduates who will be attending CUNY or SUNY colleges in the fall:

By now you are very likely aware of the fact that Governor Cuomo recently signed into law the **Excelsior Scholarship**, which will allow accepted students to attend CUNY or SUNY colleges, this fall, tuition-free, if the income of the parent(s) with whom they live is under \$100,000.

The application form for this scholarship will be made available to families on June 7th. In the meantime, college bound students should click [here](#), where they will be invited to enter their email on the Excelsior Alert Form, so that they will receive the application as soon as it becomes available.
