The only stipulation by EF is that the vouchers must be applied by November 30 for those registered or want to register for Japan; December 30 for Spain. After that, the voucher will expire, and you will lose the \$1,000 credit. Even those students who have already paid in full are eligible. If you should win, you will be reimbursed the \$1,000 by EF Tours.
