

IMPORTANT RING NIGHT INFORMATION

- Final balances are due on November 16, 2017. Please make payments out to Achieva.
- St. Saviour High School's Ring Night Ceremony will take place on Friday, December 15, 2017 at 7:00 PM at St. Saviour Church.
- All students must meet in the school gym no later than 6:30 PM.
- Parents are not allowed to enter the gym. Please drop your daughter off at school, take her coat and bag with you, and go to the church. As we will be processing into the church, no girl may carry a coat or bag as she enters.
- There are no tickets, you may bring as many guests as you like.
- Please remind your guests that the ceremony takes place in a church, so they should behave appropriately. Please have them turn off all cell phones. Photos may be taken during the ceremony, but please do not block anyone's view or interfere with the ceremony while doing so.
- Students must wear proper attire and should be dressed appropriately for church. Jeans, sneakers, "body con" dresses, low-cut tops, bare shoulders, leggings, short skirts/short dresses, and other inappropriate items of clothing are not permitted. Dress pants and a blouse would be fine. Any student dressed inappropriately will not be permitted to participate in the ceremony. If you have questions about whether or not your outfit is appropriate, please check with Ms. Cush prior to the day of the ceremony.
- The church floor and altar are slippery. Be sure that you wear shoes that you will not fall in! Each student will walk up to the altar individually to receive her ring.
- We will begin the ceremony precisely at 7 PM. If you are late, go directly to the church and go to your seat.
- Alumni family members are welcome to be a part of the ring ceremony. Mothers, sisters, aunts, grandmothers who have graduated from our school may present the student with her ring. If you are interested in participating, please drop me a note by Monday 12/4/17. Be sure to include the presenter's name, including maiden name, year of graduation, and relation to the student (sister, mother, etc). Rings may be presented by more than one person (for example, your daughter can receive her ring from both you and her aunt if you both graduated from St. Saviour HS). Presenters will be seated in a separate section to make the presentation of rings easier. Look for Ms. Cush in the church before the ceremony for instructions.
- The entire ceremony lasts approximately one hour. Group photos will be taken on the altar at the conclusion of the ceremony.
- Students who are borrowing rings should return them to Ms. Bove on following Monday.
