SAT/ACT Preparation
Winter/Spring 2021

Dear Parents:

As in years past, Saint Saviour High School will offer a course this winter/spring for students who plan to take the SAT this Spring. The ten session course, running between **February 1st and April 23rd** (the date of the exam is April 27th), will review both Verbal and Math skills and will be taught by Ms. Judith Caughey, English Department Chairperson at Saint Saviour, and Ms. Regina Bellettiere.

The sessions break down as follows: **ten** ninety minute sessions in each of the verbal and math portions of the exam, including both instruction, test strategy, and practice; **a full SAT exam**, and **two sessions** in which we will **review** the results of the practice exam, **consider** the format of the ACT, the other college entrance exam, and **answer** remaining questions and concerns. ALL lesson materials, including the book, will be supplied and are included in the **\$425.00 course fee**.

So much depends on these scores, and therefore it is important that your daughter prepare now for the SAT, or the ACT. There are other courses available (Kaplan, Princeton Review), but these typically cost up to and over one thousand dollars. Gaining familiarity with the test through the use of the many test-prep books currently on the market, as well as using online resources, is also useful, but some students have neither the time, inclination, nor discipline to attack the task independently. We hope that this course will provide additional help to students who want more formal preparation.

The class will be limited in size to twenty students (***please see note below***). Applications will be processed strictly on a first come, first served basis. Because we must pay for the lesson materials in advance, we have to insist that only students who have paid the fee in full, before the course begins, will be allowed to join the class. *We must also point out that the class will run only as long as eighteen students enroll.* Please ask your daughter to check **carefully** the class schedules below to ensure that she will be free to attend. *She should register for SAT Prep only if she is available for class on Mondays and Wednesdays, is prepared to attend all required sessions, and is willing to complete the assigned homework.* At the end of the course we will send home a record of attendance for students who have missed classes.

Schedule of Classes

Math: Wednesdays: 2/3; 2/10; 2/24; 3/3; 3/10; 3/17; 3/24; 3/31; 4/14; 4/21.

Verbal: Mondays: 2/1; 2/8; 2/22; 3/1; 3/8 ; 3/15; 3/22; 3/29; 4/12; 4/19.

All classes will be held from 3:00 to 4:30.

Please return the following registration form, along with full payment, made payable to *Saint Saviour High School*, to Ms. Caughey by Friday, January 22nd. Registration and payment can be dropped off at school according to the existing covid guidelines.
