



Dear St. Saviour High School Gaelic Society Member and family,

I am happy to announce that we will once again be marching in both the NYC St. Patrick's Day Parade and the Brooklyn Irish American Day Parade. All members are expected to participate in both of these parades. Parents are encouraged to join us in the NYC Parade. We could use your help at this major event. Parents who wish to march with us should indicate that on the tear-off. Please carefully read the details below and return the permission slip as directed. No one may march without a signed permission slip. Also, please note that we do not travel to and from the parades as a group. You must meet us at the assembly spots.

### NYC St. Patrick's Day Parade

Date: Saturday, March 16, 2019.

Assembly Time: 1:00 PM.

Assembly Place: East 45<sup>th</sup> Street between Madison Avenue and Vanderbilt Avenue, NYC. (Go to Vanderbilt Ave. end of the block). We are the last unit on the block, so look for us at the Vanderbilt Avenue end of 45<sup>th</sup> st.

Parade Route: Across 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 45<sup>th</sup> street to 79<sup>th</sup> street.

Dress Code: Green Gaelic Society Parade sweatshirt, white gloves and white scarf. (Please layer your clothing so that your parade sweatshirt is your outer layer), uniform skirt (no uniform pants are allowed), black tights or black leggings, and black shoes. No beads, stickers, face decorations, or other decorative items are allowed. SNEAKERS ARE NOT ALLOWED! Anyone dressed in appropriately will not march with our group. Parent marchers must wear business attire. Green hats, sneakers, or other "odd ball" dress is not permitted (these are the Parade Committee's rules).

Brooklyn Irish American Day Parade: (Park Slope Parade)Date: Sunday, March 17, 2019

Assembly Time: 12:15 PM. The Parade begins at 1PM and we should be finished marching by approximately 2:30 PM.

Assembly Place: Prospect Park West between 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Street.

Parade Route: Across Prospect Park West to 15<sup>th</sup> street, down 15<sup>th</sup> street to 7<sup>th</sup> avenue, up Carroll Street to Prospect Park West, ending at the reviewing stand at Bartel-Pritchard Square.

Dress Code: Green Gaelic Society Parade sweatshirt, white gloves and white scarf must be worn. Please layer your clothing so that your parade sweatshirt or St. Saviour jacket is your outer layer. Uniform skirts and shoes are not required. Jeans are okay, but ripped jeans and leggings are not allowed.

Please be aware that you will be representing St. Saviour High School to the community and therefore you are expected to be on your best behavior at all times during both days (including while traveling to and from the parades). All school rules regarding alcohol, drugs, smoking, etc. are in effect. Parents, please speak to your daughter regarding the repercussions of such behavior.

Parade Sweatshirts have been available for purchase. The personalized sweatshirts are available in both youth and adult sizes @\$50.00. Payment must be made by Monday Feb. 25, 2019. Please place payment in an envelope with your name, size, and name you want written on the sweatshirt and give this payment to Ms. Cush in Rm. 202.

Please return the permission slip by Thursday, March 7, 2019. No one will be permitted to march without a permission slip.
