

We are excited to announce the 23rd Annual Saint Saviour HS Walkathon will be held **on Friday**, **October 4** in **Prospect Park**. Walkathon makes a return after taking a break last year and we are hoping to break some fundraising records!

The 2019 Walkathon will raise money for Saint Saviour High School. With our overall goal of raising \$25,000, we are asking that you fundraise a minimum of \$125. Once you bring in the minimum of \$125, you will receive the 2019 Walkathon shirt that may be worn with your uniform every day including on Walkathon Day: Oct. 4 (except for the School Liturgy and awards ceremony). If you don't bring the minimum in by Oct. 3 – then the \$125 will be added to your FACTS account.
