IESP or 504 Parental Notice of Intent

This message is for those of you whose daughters have an IESP as well as those who are looking to pursue one. The Parental Notice of Intent guidance for the 2026-27 school year is now available at www.schools.nyc.gov/cse. You must provide notice to the CSE that you intend to continue services or that you wish to have an initial evaluation. **This must be**

sent to the CSE no later than June 1st. It is imperative that you send this letter to the CSE. Failure to send it or sending it in late will significantly impact your child; services, evaluations, and IEP updates will be delayed. See below for the basic requirements and contact for the CSE but please see the link for more in depth information. If you have any questions please feel free to contact me.

Requirements for the Parental Notice of Intent

The Notice of Intent requesting special education services must be received by the CSE on or before June 1, 2026, with the required elements listed below.

- The Notice of Intent must be submitted by the student's parent or by an attorney representing the family; and if submitted by an attorney on the family's behalf, the notice must also include a confidentiality release for the 2026-2027 school year, signed by the parent with a pen-and-ink signature. Please note that representation in a due process proceeding or other proceeding concerning a prior school year will not suffice and cannot replace the required confidentiality release for the 2026-2027 school year. *A notice of intent from a third party other than an attorney will not be accepted, with or without a confidentiality release.*

The Notice of Intent must include:

1. Name of Student
2. NYCID of Student (if known) (included on the Student's IESP)
3. Date of Birth
4. Home address
5. Parent Name
6. Parent phone number
7. Parent email address
8. Name of the school the student will attend for the 2025-2026 school year
9. Address of the school the student will attend for the 2025-2026 school year
